General Plant & Soil Care:

- Feed your soil: Add a tablespoon of worm castings to each pot. (*date:* _____)
- Support vigorous summer growth with added nutrients. Add 2 oz of liquid worm casting tea or fish emulsion biweekly. Add to your water basin or watering can. (Available in member shop) (*dates applied:* _____)
- Pot up new seedlings within a few days of their arrival. (*date planted:* _____)
- Summer pests are extra hungry! Check regularly for eggs, caterpillars and aphids. Check and wipe underside of leaves often.
- Make your own pest spray using garlic oil & peppermint Castile soap to help prevent and treat pest problems.
- Increase watering frequency as needed for warmer weather. Be sure to water deeply during warm weather.
- Harvest often to help prevent bolting and to maximize fast summer plant growth.
- Trim, remove and compost any leaves or plants that are past their prime or any greens that have bolted.
- Prune and trim any herbs that have become lanky. Trimming can also encourage new growth.

Planted Wall Care:

- Clean water basin: If your water basin hasn't been cleaned recently, it might be time to dump it and scrub it out then refill it with fresh water. (*date:* _____)
- Rotate pots or move wall to maximize or minimize sunlight depending on temps

Potted Plant Care:

- Move pots as needed to protect them from intense afternoon heat Stake tomatoes and pumpkins to support them using a tomato cage or stakes.
